

CLASSES AND EQUIPMENT

- Unlimited: Men, no restrictions on equipment, lenses allowed.
- Men's Hunter: Equipment must be what shooter hunts with. No lenses. Tournament judges will have final ruling on any questionable equipment.
- Women's and Youth classes have no restrictions on equipment.
- Youth are male and female shooters age 15 and younger.
- Shooters may shoot in only one class.

ENTRY FEES

- Unlimited: \$30 for each qualifying tournament and championship
- Men's Hunter: \$25 for each qualifying tournament and championship
- Women: \$20 for each qualifying tournament and championship
- Youth: \$20 for each qualifying tournament and championship

PRIZES

- Payouts will be determined by number of shooters in each class.
- Prizes will include a 50 percent payout to top adult finishers and trophies to top youth finishers.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- Shooters may register on the day of the shoot. Hours for each location will be 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Saturday.
- All shooters who complete both qualifying tournaments will shoot in the championship tournament.
- Each site will provide scorers; shooters will not be allowed to score their own rounds or write on their scorecards.
- Tournament will be marked yardage. Range finders are allowed.
- 14-rings will be counted only in the championship tournament.
- Shooters will have 30 minutes to repair any mechanical failures before being disqualified.
- In the event of a tie for first place in any class, shooters will shoot one target. The shooter who gets closest to the center of the 12-ring will be the winner.
- Scores from both qualifying tournaments will be averaged to place shooters in their flight (bracket) for the championship tournament.

SCRAMBLE REGULATIONS

- Scrambles will be two-man, bring-your-partner and lines will run at 6 p.m. and 8 p.m. on the Friday night of each leg of the tournament.
- Registration for the scramble will be \$30 per person for unlimited, \$25 per person for hunter class and registration will close an hour before each line. Pre-registration will be available by calling the tournament locations prior to the scramble.
- In the event of a tie, shooters will shoot at a five-spot target. The arrow closest to the X will win the tie and the lower score will take the next place.
